Summary:

The word "Heart" can be found multiple times in scriptures. And, when it does appear, it seldom simply means the organ in your chest, the muscle that pumps and pumps. It doesn't talk about what your doctor wants to check regularly with EKG and blood tests. In the Bible, "heart" refers to such things as personality, intellect, memory, emotions, desires and the will of man. In this week's sermon, Bishop Paul Ojeda examines the heart of the believer and the reshaping of your heart through God's vision for your life. God wants you to enjoy what He enjoys. You are God's special work. unique, a once in an eternity person created beautifully by Him. God is at a consent work in you and through you. God is interested in you, your heart and your life.
